

Advanced Junior Program

The Advanced Program is for students that have graduated from the Developmental program or have been pre-approved by a Broadlands junior golf coach. These students play in a 9-hole golf league each Thursday morning starting June 15th for up to 9 weeks. Students also participate in individual lessons scheduled with a coach during the summer.

Benefits for all Students

Broadlands Junior Golf Program will provide golf clubs for students if needed.

Junior Golf participants receive a Broadlands Kid's Card that entitles them to half price buckets of range balls and free twilight golf when accompanied by a paying adult during 2023.

Juniors in Level 5 or Advanced also have the option to play 9 holes for only \$10 before 8:30 a.m. Monday-Thursday or at twilight any day (no adult required).

Prizes, awards, games, and instruction materials are also included.

Junior Golf 2023 Overview

Broadlands Junior Golf Program is for anyone between the ages of 6 and 17. Our goals are to help junior golfers have fun, play better, and play more.

The Developmental Junior Program is for beginners + intermediate students. The Advanced Junior Program is designed for older students with more golf experience.

What is the Developmental Junior Program all about?

The Developmental Program consists of Practice Days and Golf Days that help our students have fun while learning to golf.

Any child with a desire to play golf is welcome to participate. **No experience or equipment is necessary.**

Developmental Practice Days

Students are divided into skill levels during Practice Days.

Practice Days take place for up to 9 weeks on Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday mornings beginning on June 14th and last for two hours. Practice Days include golf instruction and practice with our coaches

plus fun games and contests. Prizes and achievement pins are awarded weekly.

Developmental Program Info

Broadlands Golf Club's 2023 Developmental Program uses the US Kids Player Pathway system as a guide for teaching and course set up. It allows students with a similar skill level to learn and play together. Each child receives an instruction booklet to track progress. Achievement pins are awarded each time a student passes a skill test. After all five skill tests (listed below) in a level are passed, then the student graduates to the next level.

Skill tests include **putting, around the green, full swing, knowledge and scoring.**

Developmental Golf Days

Golf Days take place on Monday + Tuesday mornings. Golf Days allow students to experience golf on a real course. Yardage and number of holes played increases with each skill level.

Blue - Level 1

1. 9 Holes = approximately 450 yards
2. Golf day: 4 holes
3. Basic grip, set up, putting, around the green, and full swing skills.

Orange – Level 2

1. 9 holes = approximately 900 yards
2. Golf day: 6 holes
3. Juniors will develop speed, control, and aim.

Red - Level 3

1. 9 holes = approximately 1,350 yards
2. Golf day: 9 holes
3. Add pre-shot routines and refine your target and aim.

NEW Green - Level 4

1. 9 holes = approximately 1,350 yards
2. Golf day: 9 holes
3. Further develop and maintain a good swing to shoot lower scores.

NEW Gold - Level 5

1. 9 holes = approximately 1,350 yards
2. Golf day: 9 holes
3. Putting it all Together:
Plan → Setup → Play
